Dundee Jazz Festival aims to spotlight the most exciting and brilliant jazz and blues talents such as those as Soweto Kinch, Nikki Hill Band, Tommy Smith, Aaron Diehl, Rose Room. Dundee Jazz Festival announced a star-studded line-up, which will delight Festival regulars and first-timers alike. For its 34th edition, Dundee will play host to the finest jazz and blues talent from the local and international scene. This year's festival programme is refreshed and widely varied, offering a different flavour every night, from modern jazz, to swing, blues, soul, vintage and gypsy jazz.

Key Facts

- The Festival lasts from the **16th to the 20th of November** and has been running for 34 years.
- We have international guests as well as Scottish musicians entailing fresh young talents and well-established artists with careers of more of 20 years.
- The Gardyne Theatre will host the core programme of the Festival.
- For the first time, the Reading Rooms hosts a concert (Soweto Kinch);
- And the late jazz night sessions at the Rep are back! (with Gordon McNeil Quintet)

- The popular laid back afternoon “Jazz in the Ferry” will be back on Sunday 20 November, with top notch Scottish musicians for 3 hours of high quality music across six different venues.
- An intimate concert will be presented at the quirky Frigate Unicorn.
- We aim to offer audiences the opportunity to fully experience the Festival vibe and to encourage the discovery of the various new acts and attendance at more than one concert, we’re offering promotions on tickets.

Volunteer Roles

Concert Management/Artist Liaison

Main Responsibility:

To assist the Concert Manager (and Front of House Manager if required) to ensure the smooth running of sound checks and concerts within the festival.

Main duties include:

- Welcoming artists and being available during rehearsals and concerts to assist them and answer to any questions
- Assist with stage management, including setting up the stage with music stands, chairs, etc.
- Liaising with venue staff
- Ensure the concerts run smoothly and to time
- Welcoming audiences and providing information regarding concerts/Festival
- Doing everything possible to ensure that the concert runs smoothly and to time
- Dress venue where required and putting up posters and signs

Video Recording Team

Main responsibility:

Record concerts presented at this year's Dundee Jazz Festival, using a video camera owned by the festival.

Main duties include:

- Record videos of the concerts
- Liaise with the Festival before the editing process to discussed format and details
- Edit recordings to create short videos that will be published online by the festival

Please note that for this role we require you to have experience in using a professional video camera as well as to have access to video editing softwares.

Photographer

Main responsibility:

Take photos in the back stage and during the concerts presented at this year's Dundee Jazz Festival.

Main duties include:

- Liaise with the Festival to discuss briefing for photos
- Take shots of the festival in action (back stage, concerts)
- Share product with the Festival for publishing via Festival's online channels.

Please note you are expected to provide own camera for this role.

PR/Street Team

Main responsibility:

Assisting the Marketing Manager with the distribution of promotional material in an effective and efficient manner and attend promotional events.

Main duties include:

- Distributing flyers, posters and other promotional material in appropriate places
- Liaising with venue staff and Jazz Scotland

- Dress venue where required and putting up posters and signs

- Outgoing and happy to deal with the public
- Good customer service skills - friendly and patient
- Active and hands-on
- Volunteers must be aged over 18

Dress Code: Smart Casual (dark clothes preferred)

If volunteering as Management Assistant of Front of House, you will be required to arrive at the venue approximately 1/1.5h prior to concert start.

There are roles suited to all levels of experience, providing opportunities to gain new skills and experience, or to use existing skills to support Dundee Jazz Festival and help contribute to the Festival's success.
